

## Inserting the battery pack and routing the EFGI 650 cables



















- 1. The battery cell is inserted into the pocket on the back to position it as high as possible in the backpack
- 2. Pull the elastane insert over the edges of the battery pack housing
- 3. Push the battery pack into the bag with light pressure
- 4. Lead the connection cable out of the backpack through the tab below the carrying handle
- 5. Insert the cathode and battery pack connectors through the carrying handle
- 6. There is another tab on both shoulder straps through which the plugs can be fed
- 7. Guided in this way, the cables reach the control unit cleanly and do not restrict your freedom of movement
  - ... for the journey to the water, stow the connection cables in the side pockets
- 8. Stow the cathode in the side compartment of the backpack and secure it with the quick-release strap
- 9. You can store the anode cable opposite and also secure it against loss.
